Major credit card companies joined to create the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS), which originated from Visa's Card Information Security Program (CISP). This initiative requires that merchants accepting credit card transactions maintain a secure credit card process. All merchants must follow guidelines for access, storage, and use of credit card data, and they follow internal processes and procedures, including documenting changes to the process and testing security of internal networks.

Meets Payment Automation Best Practices Standard

The Payment Card Industry has established standards for software vendors incorporated in the Payment Automation Best Practices (PABP) program. As stated by Visa:

“Visa developed the PABP to assist software vendors in creating secure payment applications, thereby helping to protect their customers from being exposed to a security breach. As stated in the PABP, Visa prohibits the retention of full magnetic-stripe (“track”) data, Card Verification Value 2 (“CVV2”) and PIN blocks—all critical impediments to achieving PCI DSS compliance. In addition to preventing the retention of prohibited data, the PABP requires payment applications to include security controls in support of a merchant or service provider’s ability to comply with the PCI DSS.”

To become a certified PABP vendor, EdgCapture Release 4 was reviewed by an independent software auditing firm to ensure the application meets PABP standards. By having PABP certification, EdgCapture R4 supports the merchant's ability to comply with PCI DSS.
